XIT's fiber optic construction project in Dalhart continues, and crews are making steady gains each week with buried fiber now being installed in the Pueblo Addition in southeast Dalhart. The process is slow due to all the existing utilities buried in the alleyways. Aerial fiber crews have been busy working in the Denver, Denrock, Monte Vista, Lake Road areas and adjoining neighborhoods.

Lifeline Assistance

If you need assistance with paying your telephone or Internet bill, the Lifeline program is available to qualifying low-income residents as part of a federal support program.

Lifeline is available from XIT Rural Telephone Cooperative, Inc. and XIT Communications and provides a monthly discount on basic telephone or Internet service.

- If you use the discount for Internet service, you must subscribe to XIT's 12/2 or higher Internet package to be eligible for the discount.
- There is only one discount allowed per household for either telephone or Internet, but not for both.
- In order to receive Lifeline assistance, you or someone in your household must participate in at least one of the following programs: Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI), Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance (FPHA), Veterans Pension and Survivors Benefit Program, or your annual household income must be at or below 135% of the federal poverty guidelines. Additional assistance may be available for residents of Tribal lands.
- Subscribers will need to recertify once a year.

Updated Reverse Number Lookup on XIT Website

Do Not Call Registries

Are you one of the many people getting frustrated with annoying telemarketing and sales calls? If so, there are a few things you can do to cut down on these types of calls. Make sure you have put your telephone numbers on the Federal and Texas No-Call registries. Both the Federal government and State of Texas have telemarketing rules that allow consumers to give notice to telemarketers that they do not wish to be contacted by them. Charities, political calls, surveys and debt collection calls are exempt from these rules.

You can register for the Texas No-Call List by going online at www.TexasNoCall.com. Fill out the online form and click Register. It is free to register your telephone numbers on the website. The site is available 24 hours a day,

7 days a week. You will need to re-register your phone numbers every 3 years on the Texas website.

You can also register for the Texas No-Call List by mail. Print the form on the website and mail it to: Texas No-Call, 100 Summer Street, Suite 800, Boston, MA. 02110.

Make sure to also register for the Federal Do-Not-Call List on the website at www.DoNotCall.gov. Registration on this site is also free and it never expires. Once you register your telephone numbers, they stay on the site until you take them off. Just make sure to use a valid email address because it is needed to verify your registration on the site. Once you register, you will receive an email confirmation that contains a link you must click on within 72 hours to complete your registration.

You can also sign up for the Federal Do-Not-Call List by telephone. Call toll-free I-888-382-1222 to register by phone. You must call on a phone associated with the phone number that you want to register.

By taking these steps, you can cut down on the number of telemarketing calls you receive.


